

# CONFLICT OF INTEREST QUESTIONNAIRE

For vendor or other person doing business with local governmental entity

FORM CIQ

This questionnaire reflects change made to the law by H.B. 1491, 80th Leg., Regular Session. This question has been added to the law with Chapter 176, Local Government Code by a person or persons at a public meeting as required by Section 176.001(1) with a local governmental entity and the person meets requirements under Section 176.002(a).

By law the person shall file this form with the records administrator of the local governmental entity, not later than the start of business day, after the date the person becomes aware of facts that require the statement to be filed under Section 176.006, Local Government Code.

A person is liable for an offense if the person knowingly violates Section 176.006, Local Government Code. An affirmative defense to the section is a clause, no misdemeanor.
