

At a regular meeting of Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 27th day of May, 2003, on motion made by Commissioner Matthews and seconded by Commissioner Thompson, the following Order was adopted:

ORDER NO. 2003-03

IT IS ORDERED that smoking or burning of tobacco be prohibited as of the 1st day of June, 2003, in all Johnson County buildings and facilities and on the property within twenty-five (25) feet of the entrance to said buildings and facilities owned, leased, rented and/or operated by Johnson County, Texas with Johnson County personnel on the premises.


A person commits an offense if he/she smokes tobacco or is in possession of a burning tobacco product in any Johnson County building or facility owned, leased, rented, and/or operated by Johnson County, Texas with Johnson County personnel on said premises; or if he/she is on the property and smokes tobacco or is in possession of a

burning tobacco product within twenty-five (25) feet of the entrance to a building or facility owned, leased, rented, and/or operated by Johnson County, Texas with Johnson County personnel on said premises. A violation of this order is punishable as a Class C misdemeanor with a fine not to exceed \$500.00.

JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS

SMOKING OR BURNING OF TOBACCO

A person commits an offense if he/she smokes tobacco or is in possession of a burning tobacco product in any Johnson County building or facility owned, leased, rented, and/or operated by Johnson County, Texas with Johnson County personnel on said premises; or if he/she is on the property and smokes tobacco or is in possession of a burning tobacco product within twenty-five (25) feet of the entrance to a building or facility owned, leased, rented, and/or operated by Johnson County, Texas with Johnson County personnel on said premises. A violation of this order is punishable as a Class C misdemeanor with a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
