**ORDER DESIGNATING THE COUNTY JUDGE THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE  
A DETERMINATION TO RESCIND A BURN BAN ORDER**

---

**WHEREAS**, the 82<sup>nd</sup> Texas Legislature passed S.B. 1233 and H.B. 1174 which amended Section 352.081 of the Local Government Code to authorize the Commissioners Court to designate the County Judge the authority to make a determination that circumstances no longer exists in all or part of the unincorporated area to create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court has determined that a burn ban order may need to be rescinded at a time that may not be convenient for the Commissioners Court to meet; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court desires to designate the County Judge the authority to make a determination to rescind a burn ban order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Commissioners Court designates the County Judge, pursuant to Section 352.081 of the Local Government Code, the authority to make a determination to rescind a burn ban order.


