**DECREASE OF SPEED LIMIT FOR PASSENGER CARS AND TRUCKS FROM 40 MPH TO 30 MPH ON ELDORADO DRIVE, ELDORADO ESTATES ADDITION IN PRECINCT #3, JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on September, 28, 2009 in regular session and held a public hearing to consider "Decrease of Speed Limit for passenger cars and trucks on Eldorado Drive, Eldorado Estates Addition, in Precinct #3" of Johnson County, Texas.

The Public Hearing was properly published in the Burleson Star, on the County Web Page and on the bulletin board of the Johnson County Commissioners Court at the Johnson County Courthouse on Sunday, September 20, 2009.

The Commissioners Court made the following findings:

1. Eldorado Drive, Eldorado Estates Addition is in a residence district,
2. A city planning commission has not designated Eldorado Drive, Eldorado Estates Addition as a major thoroughfare, and
3. A speed limit of more than 30 miles per hour on Eldorado Drive, Eldorado Estates Addition is unreasonable or unsafe.


A motion was made by Commissioner Stringer and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve "Decrease of Speed Limit for passenger cars and trucks from 40 MPH to 30 MPH on Eldorado Drive, Eldorado Estates Addition in Precinct #3" of Johnson County, Texas.

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this order to Decrease the Speed Limit for passenger cars and trucks from 40 MPH to 30 MPH on Eldorado Drive, Eldorado Estates Addition in Precinct #3 of Johnson County, Texas.
