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**COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT WESTHILL CONSTRUCTION, INC. PROVIDING AN ASPHALT LAYDOWN MACHINE AND OPERATOR FOR PAVING OF A PARKING LOT IS A SERVICE THAT CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ONLY ONE SOURCE**

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The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on September 28, 2020, in regular session for the consideration that the services provided by Westhill Construction, Inc. for an asphalt laydown machine and operator for paving of a parking lot in Johnson County, Texas is a service that can be obtained from only one source. **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:**




