COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE SERVICES PROVIDED BY TEXAS HEALTH PHYSICIAN'S GROUP FOR OBGYN SERVICES ARE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on April 11, 2022 in regular session for the consideration of a contract between Johnson County, Texas and Texas Health Physician's Group for OBGYN services for inmates at the Johnson County Corrections Facility, the Commissioners Court finds that this contract is for professional services and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey, Pct. #1 and seconded by Commissioner Howell, Pct. #2 that: "The Commissioners Court find the contract with Texas Health Physician's Group for OBGYN services, is a contract for professional services and that the Commissioners Court grants an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an Order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the contract with Texas Health Physician's Group for OBGYN services."

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 11th day of April, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this Order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the contract with Texas Health Physician's Group for OBGYN services is a contract for professional services.


