ORDER 2023-32

COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE PURCHASE OF A VEHICLE FOR PRECINCT 4 IS A PURCHASE DUE TO A CASE OF PUBLIC CALAMITY (EMERGENCY) AND IT IS NECESSARY TO MAKE THE PURCHASE PROMPTLY TO PRESERVE THE PROPERTY OF THE COUNTY

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on **May 8, 2023** in regular session for the consideration of a purchase for Precinct 4 of a 2023 2500HD 4x4 Double Cab truck from Caldwell Country Chevrolet. The Commissioners Court finds that this vehicle purchase is a vehicle that must be purchased in a case of public calamity (emergency) and it is necessary to make the purchase promptly to preserve the property of the county and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.


A motion was made by Commissioner Woolley, Pct. 4 and seconded by Commissioner Howell, Pct. 2 that "The Commissioners Court finds the vehicle purchase is a vehicle that must be purchased in a case of public calamity (emergency) and it is necessary to make the purchase promptly to preserve the property of the county and that the Commissioners Court grants an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an Order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the purchase of the 2023 2500HD 4x4 Double Cab truck from Caldwell Country Chevrolet."

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 8TH DAY OF MAY, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:




