COUNTY OF JOHNSON

COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE ALARM SYSTEM FOR THE GUINN JUSTICE CENTER IS A PURCHASE NECESSARY BECAUSE OF UNFORESEEN DAMAGE TO PUBLIC PROPERTY AND IS AN ITEM NECESSARY TO PRESERVE OR PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF JOHNSON COUNTY

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on May 17, 2023 in an emergency called session for the consideration of deliberating the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices at the Guinn Justice Center. The Commissioners Court finds that the purchase of a fire alarm system for the Guinn Justice Center is a purchase necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property and is an item necessary to protect the public health or safety of the residents of the county and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Woolley, Pct. 4 and seconded by Commissioner Bailey, Pct. 1 that "The Commissioners Court finds that the purchase of a fire alarm system for the Guinn Justice Center is a purchase necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property and is an item necessary to protect the public health or safety of the residents of the county and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code and enter an Order to that effect and that the Commissioners Court approve the purchase of a fire alarm system from Elyon Fire & Life Safety, LLC."

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 17TH DAY OF MAY, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:


The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this Order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the purchase of a fire alarm system from Elyon Fire & Life Safety, LLC for the Guinn Justice Center is a purchase necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property and is an item necessary to protect the public health or safety of the residents of the county and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.






