COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE LEASE OF HVAC EQUIPMENT FROM WALKER ENGINEERING FOR THE GUINN JUSTICE CENTER IS A PURCHASE NECESSARY BECAUSE OF UNFORESEEN DAMAGE TO PUBLIC PROPERTY AND IS AN ITEM NECESSARY TO PRESERVE OR PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF JOHNSON COUNTY

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on June 21, 2023 in an emergency called session for the consideration of deliberating the lease of HVAC equipment from Walker Engineering for the Guinn Justice Center as a purchase necessary because of unforeseen damage to public property and an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County.
