AN ORDER OF THE COUNTY OF JOHNSON REPEALING THE JUVENILE CURFEW PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED BY TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE § 370.002 AS REQUIRED BY 88 (R) HB 1819; TO BE EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2023

WHEREAS, Johnson County, Texas, previously adopted a juvenile curfew in compliance with Texas Local Government Code Section 370.002; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature repealed the authority of counties to adopt juvenile curfews by passing HB 1819 in the 88th Legislature; and

WHEREAS, under Section 370.007 of the Texas Local Government Code, "a political subdivision may not adopt or enforce an order...that imposes a curfew" on juveniles; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2023, the County will no longer have the authority to enforce a juvenile curfew.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The juvenile curfew in Johnson County is hereby repealed, effective September 1, 2023.

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 10th day of July 2023.
