COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY SYMETRIA HEALTH OF TEXAS, LLC ARE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on May 13, 2024 in regular session for the consideration of a contract between Johnson County, Texas and Symetria Health of Texas, LLC, the Commissioners Court finds that this contract is for professional services and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this Order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the contract for medical services and drug treatment services with Symetria Health of Texas, LLC is a contract for professional services.
