COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS AND CONTRACTORS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE HEADWALLS FOR THE CULVERTS AND FOR PAVING ON THE COUNTY ROAD KNOWN AS "OLD FOAMY" ARE PURCHASES DUE TO UNFORESEEN DAMAGE TO PUBLIC PROPERTY

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on June 10, 2024 in regular session for the consideration of a purchase of materials and contractors for the construction of concrete headwalls for the culverts and for paving on the county road known as "Old Foamy" are purchases due to unforeseen damage to public property and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this Order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the purchase of materials and contractors for the construction of concrete headwalls for the culverts and for paving on the county road known as "Old Foamy" are purchases due to unforeseen damage to public property and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.
