COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT A CONTRACT FOR THE REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF CULVERTS ON CREEK CROSSING IS A PURCHASE DUE TO UNFORESEEN DAMAGE TO PUBLIC PROPERTY
