RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE EVS 6300 VOTING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the EVS 6300 voting system by Elections System & Software is comprised of the ExpressVote ballot marking device, and the DS950 Central Scanner; and

WHEREAS, Section 123.035 of the Texas Election Code requires that use of new voting equipment must be approved by the Elections Division of the office of the Texas Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, the County has received approval from the State of Texas for purchase of the ES&S EVS 6300 voting system that is certified for use in Texas as described in a letter dated October 4, 2023 which is attached; and

WHEREAS, the Johnson County Elections Department, acting by and through the Johnson County Commissioners Court, has purchased the new ADA-compliant EVS 6300 voting system to be used for early and regular election day voting by Johnson County for the November 5, 2024 election and all subsequent elections; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 123.001 (b) of the Texas Election Code, Johnson County must formally adopt said voting system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Johnson County Commissioners Court does hereby adopt the ES&S EVS 6300 voting system, as certified by the State of Texas, to be used for early and regular election day voting by Johnson County for the November election and all subsequent elections.
