**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COUNTY GRANT PROGRAM YEAR 2025**

---

A resolution of the County of Johnson, Texas, certifying that the County has made a grant to Meals on Wheels North Central Texas, an organization that provides home-delivered meals to homebound persons in the County who are elderly and/or have a disability, and certifying that the County has approved the Organization's accounting system or fiscal agent.

**WHEREAS**, the Organization seeks to apply for grant funds from the Texas Department of Agriculture to supplement and extend existing services for homebound persons in the County who are elderly and/or have a disability pursuant to the Home-Delivered Meal Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Program rules require the County in which an Organization is providing home-delivered meal services to make a grant to the Organization in order for the Organization to be eligible to receive Program grant funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Program rules further require the County approve the Organization's accounting system or fiscal agent in order for the Organization to be eligible to receive Program grant funds.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY:**

SECTION 1: The County hereby certifies that it has made a grant to the Organization in the amount of \$83,000.00, to be used between the:

1<sup>st</sup> of October 2024 and the 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2025

SECTION 2: The County hereby certifies that the Organization provides home-delivered meals to homebound persons in the County who are elderly and/or have a disability.


