COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE MAYFLOWER LAW ENFORCEMENT PLATE CARRIER MANUFACTURED BY VELOCITY SYSTEMS AND SOLD BY SPECIAL OPERATIONS SYSTEM, LLC IS AN ITEM THAT CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ONLY ONE SOURCE

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on May 11, 2018, in a special called session for the consideration that the purchase of the Mayflower Law Enforcement Plate Carrier manufactured by Velocity Systems is an item that can be obtained from only one source. The Commissioners Court finds the Mayflower Law Enforcement Plate Carrier is designed specifically for the Johnson County Sheriff's Office to include modifications that are unique to the design and available only through Velocity Systems and sold by Special Operations System, LLC and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Howell, Precinct #2 and seconded by Commissioner Stringer, Precinct #3 that: "The Commissioners Court finds that the purchase of the Mayflower Law Enforcement Plate Carrier manufactured by Velocity Systems and sold by Special Operations System, LLC is an item that can be obtained from only one source and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the purchase of the Mayflower Law Enforcement Plate Carrier manufactured by Velocity Systems and sold

by Special Operations System, LLC as an item that can be obtained from only one source".

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 11th day of May, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the purchase of the Mayflower Law Enforcement Plate Carrier manufactured by Velocity Systems and sold by Special Operations System, LLC is an item that can be obtained from only one source.
