COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT SERVICES PROVIDED BY ALLISON, BASS & MAGEE, L.L.P. FOR THE REDISTRICTING OF JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS IS A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on March 9, 2020, in regular session for the consideration that the services provided by Allison, Bass & Magee, L.L.P. for the redistricting of Johnson County, Texas based upon the 2020 census count is a professional service. The Commissioners Court finds that the services provided by Allison, Bass & Magee, L.L.P. for the redistricting of Johnson County, Texas based upon the 2020 census count is a professional service and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.


