WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate further spread of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 issued a Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency for Johnson County should continue for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public.

A motion was made by Commissioner Stringer, Pct #3, and seconded by Commissioner Woolley, Pct. #4, that: "The Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency issued by County Judge Roger Harmon on March 19, 2020, at 4:50 p.m. be continued for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public and that said Declaration of Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency continue in effect until terminated by the County Judge."

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:**


