WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson on the 19th day of March, 2020 issued a Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency for Johnson County should continue for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public.
