COMMISSIONERS COURT APPROVAL OF COUNTY OF JOHNSON, TEXAS COUNTY JUDGE SIXTH AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH **EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate further spread of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Johnson on the 23rd day of April, 2020 issued a Sixth Amendment to Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the Sixth Amendment to Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency for Johnson County should continue for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public.

A motion was made by Commissioner Howell, Pct. #2, and seconded by Commissioner Woolley, Pct. #4, that: "The Sixth Amendment to Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency issued by County Judge Roger Harmon on April 23, 2020, at 2:15 p.m. be continued for a period of more than seven days for the health and safety of the public and that said Sixth Amendment to Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency continue in effect until terminated by the County Judge."
